No. S.R.O. 446-L/80/WE/M-7/79.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 133 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, the President, after consultation with the Bangladesh Public Service Commission as required by clause (2) of article 140 of that Constitution, is pleased to make the following rules, namely:—

THE DEPARTMENT OF SHIPPING (ENGINEER AND SHIP SURVEYOR
OF INLAND SHIPS) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1980.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Department of Shipping (Engineer and Ship Surveyor of Inland Ships) Recruitment Rules, 1980.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

- (a) "appointing authority" means the Government;
- (b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;
- (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to the specified post;
- (d) "requisite qualification" means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to the specified post;
- (e) "Schedule" means the Schedule annexed to these rules; and
- (f) "specified post" means the post specified in the Schedule.

3. **Procedure for recruitment.**—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule and instructions relating to reservation for the purpose of clause (3) of article 29 of the Constitution of the People's Republic of Bangladesh, appointment to the specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment; or
- (b) by transfer on deputation.

(2) No person shall be appointed to the specified post unless he has the requisite qualification and, in the case of direct recruitment, he is also within the age limit laid down in the Schedule for that post:

Provided that the upper limit of age may be relaxed, in the case of a person who has already been appointed to the specified post on *ad hoc* basis, by such period as he may have been holding the post continuously as an *ad hoc* appointee.

4. **Appointment by direct recruitment.**—(1) No appointment to the specified post by direct recruitment shall be made by the appointing authority except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of Bangladesh, or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in, Bangladesh;
- (b) is married to, or has entered into a promise of marriage with, a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to the specified post by direct recruitment shall be made by the appointing authority unless—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services to be medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to the specified post unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission while inviting applications for the specified post; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Probation.**—(1) Persons selected for appointment to the specified post by direct recruitment against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment :

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period, terminate his service.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation, including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

- (a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and
- (b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may terminate his service.

Explanation.—The period of probation of a probationer shall be deemed to have been extended if no order under this sub-rule has been made.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in the specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, prescribe by order.
