No. S.R.O. 481-L/83.—The following draft of certain further amendment in the Motor Vehicles Rules, 1940, which it is proposed to make in exercise of the powers conferred by section 70 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1939 (IV of 1939), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of section 133 of the said Act, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby, and notice is hereby given that the draft will be taken into consideration on or after the 29th December 1983. Any objection or suggestion received from any person in respect of the said draft on or before the date specified above will be taken into consideration by the Government:

Draft Amendment.

In the aforesaid Rules, for rule 162A, the following shall be *substituted*, namely :—

“162A. **Painting of bodies of motor cab (taxi, auto-rickshaw and scooter).**—The body of every motor cab (taxi, auto-rickshaw and scooter) plying for hire or reward shall be painted with yellow colour on top and black colour on the rest of the body :

Provided that the auto-rickshaws owned by Auto-rickshaw Owners' Co-operatives shall have a 9 (nine) inches wide yellow line at the middle of the black body.”

PROCLAMATION

Martial Law Case No. 101/83, G.R. Case No. 20/83, under
section 409 BPC and 11 MLR/82

Whereas it has been made to appear to me that the accused Haripada Barmon, Ex-Tahsilder, Vested-Property Circle Officer's (Rev) Office, Chatmohar, Dist. Pabna, son of Radha Charan Barmon, at present Vill. Kumar Mada, P. S. Joydebpur, Dist. Dhaka, is required for the purpose of trial in the Summary Martial Law Court No. 8, Bogra ;

And whereas the Court has reason to believe that the said accused Haripada Barmon, Ex-Tahsilder in the abovementioned case, is absconding or concealing himself to avoid appearance or arrest for the said purpose ;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Regulation 2(11) of the Martial Law Regulation No. 1 of 1982, this Summary Martial Law Court No. 8, Bogra, do hereby direct the aforesaid person to appear in this court at 10 a. m. on 9th January 1984 in abovementioned case, failing which he will be tried *in absentia* and his properties, both movable and immovable, may be forfeited to the Government.
