No. S.R.O. 483-L/83.—In pursuance of the Proclamation of the 24th March, 1982, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President and Chief Martial Law Administrator is pleased to make the following rules, namely :—

THE NON-CADRE GAZETTED OFFICERS AND NON-GAZETTED EMPLOYEES (DIRECTOR GENERAL OF FOOD) RECRUITMENT RULES, 1983.

1. **Short title.**—These rules may be called the Non-Cadre Gazetted Officers and Non-Gazetted Employees (Director-General of Food) Recruitment Rules, 1983.

2. **Definitions.**—In these rules unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context,—

(a) "appointing authority" means, in relation to the specified post at serial No. 1, the Government, and in relation to other specified post, the Director-General of Food and includes any other officer authorised by him to make appointment to such post or class of posts;

(b) "Commission" means the Bangladesh Public Service Commission;

- (c) "probationer" means a person appointed on probation to a specified post;
- (d) "recognised University" means a University established by or under any law for the time being in force and includes any other university declared by the Government, after consultation with the Commission, to be a recognised University for the purpose of these rules;
- (e) "requisite qualification" in relation to a specified post, means the qualification laid down in the Schedule in relation to that post;
- (f) "Schedule" means the Schedules annexed to these rules; and
- (g) "specified post" means a post specified in the Schedule.

3 Procedure for appointment.—(1) Subject to the provisions of the Schedule, appointment to a specified post shall be made—

- (a) by direct recruitment;
- (b) by promotion; or
- (c) by transfer.

4. Appointment by direct recruitment.—(1) No appointment to a specified post other than Class-III and Class-IV posts by direct recruitment shall be made except upon the recommendation of the Commission.

(2) No person shall be eligible for appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment, if he—

- (a) is not a citizen of or a permanent resident of, or domiciled in Bangladesh; or
- (b) is married to or has entered into a promise of marriage with a person who is not a citizen of Bangladesh.

(3) No appointment to a specified post by direct recruitment shall be made until—

- (a) the person selected for appointment is certified, in the case of the posts at serial nos. 1—4, by a Medical Board set up for the purpose by the Director of Health Services and in the case of other posts, by an authorised Medical Officer that he is medically fit for such appointment and that he does not suffer from any such organic defect as is likely to interfere with the discharge of the duties of the specified post; and
- (b) the antecedents of the person so selected have been verified through appropriate agencies and found to be such as do not render him unfit for appointment in the service of the Republic.

(4) No person shall be recommended for appointment to specified posts, other than Class-III and Class-IV posts, unless—

- (a) he applied in such form, accompanied by such fee and before such date, as was notified by the Commission; and
- (b) in the case of a person already in Government service or in the service of a local authority, he applied through his official superior.

5. **Appointment by promotion.**—(1) Appointment by promotion to a specified post shall be made on the recommendation of such Departmental Promotion Committee as the Government may constitute in this behalf :

Provided that appointment by promotion to a specified post of higher class other than Class-III and Class-IV posts shall be made on recommendation of the Commission.

(2) A person shall not be eligible for appointment by promotion to a specified post if he has unsatisfactory records of service.

6. **Probation.**—(1) A person selected for appointment to a specified post against a substantive vacancy shall be appointed on probation,—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, for a period of two years from the date of substantive appointment; and

(b) in the case of promotion, for a period of one year from the date of such appointment :

Provided that the appointing authority may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, extend the period of probation by a period or periods so that the extended period does not exceed two years in the aggregate.

(2) Where, during the period of probation of a probationer, the appointing authority is of opinion that his conduct and work is unsatisfactory or that he is not likely to become efficient, it may, before the expiry of that period,—

(a) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(b) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(3) After the completion of the period of probation including the extended period, if any, the appointing authority,—

(a) if it is satisfied that the conduct and work of the probationer during his period of probation has been satisfactory, shall, subject to the provisions of sub-rule (4), confirm him; and

(b) if it is of opinion that the conduct and work of the probationer during that period was not satisfactory, may :—

(i) in the case of direct recruitment, terminate his service; and

(ii) in the case of promotion, revert him to the post from which he was promoted.

(4) A probationer shall not be confirmed in a specified post until he has passed such examination and undergone such training as the Government may, from time to time, prescribe by order.

7. These Rules supersede all the previous rules in respect of the post included in the Schedule annexed to these rules.

No. S.R.O.484-L/83/Misc-3/81(Poll-IV)/777.—In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 9 of the Manoeuvres, Field Firing and Artillery Practice Act, 1938 (V of 1938), the Government is pleased hereby to give notice of its intention to issue notification under sub-section (2) of the said section authorising the carrying out of field firing and artillery practice throughout the area (Faujdarhat-Halishahar Range in the district of Chittagong) as defined in this Ministry's Notification No. S.R.O. 269-L/82/Misc-3/81(Poll-IV) 411, dated the 10th July, 1982 and also specified in the Schedule below :

(iii) Minister/Advisors (with the rank and status of a Minister)/DCMLAs.	One saloon.
(iv) Speaker of the National Assembly	One saloon.
(v) Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Bangladesh.	One saloon.
(vi) Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission.	One saloon.
(vii) Chief Election Commissioner	One saloon.
(viii) Secretary, Cabinet Division	One saloon.
(ix) Chief of Staff of Army, Navy and Air Forces.	One saloon.

Note.—(A) A newly elected President on taking up the office and a President on leave is entitled to the use of an air-conditioned saloon if available, otherwise an ordinary saloon may be provided.

Note.—(B) Deputy Chief Martial Law Administrators and the members of the Council of Advisors/Ministers are entitled to travel in saloon while undertaking journey by rail at Government expenses while on duty and they may take their families and by family it is meant wife and two children only.

Note.—(C) An out-going Minister can avail himself of the travelling facilities admissible to him under the rules within a period of six months of the date of laying down his offices.

Note.—(D) The Chief Justice of Bangladesh may take his wife with him without payment of any fare in a Railway saloon so reserved on H.O.R. when proceeding on tour within Bangladesh exceeding five days in duration.

Note.—(E) Deputy Chairman, Planning Commission and Chief Election Commissioner when travelling on official duty is entitled to the use of saloon if available. Their families are not allowed to travel free of charges in the saloon allowed to them on H.O.R.

Note.—(F) Expenses will be borne by the respective Ministry/Division/Departments by accepting the debits raised by the Railways Accounts Department on the strength of the H.O.R. Warrant so submitted at station.

2. The following officials of the Government of Bangladesh are entitled to travel in a reserved 1st Class four berthed compartment in the ordinary train service or in a reserved coup (two berths) compartment in Air-conditioned Coach, if available on H.O.R. on payment of fare for two/four berths as the case may be with reservation fees:—

- (i) State Ministers.
- (ii) Deputy Ministers/Deputy Speaker.
- (iii) Comptroller and Auditor General of Bangladesh.
- (iv) Judges of Supreme/High Courts.
- (v) Attorney General of Bangladesh.

Note.—A Judge of the supreme Court and High Court may take his wife with him without payment of fare in accommodation so reserved by the Railway on H.O.R. when proceeding on tour within Bangladesh exceeding of five days duration.

3. The following VIPs/Officers of the Government of Bangladesh are entitled to travel in a reserved 1st Class coup (2 berths) compartments in the ordinary trains service or a reserved coup (2 berths) compartment in an air-conditioned coup, if available on proper tickets on priority basis superseding the normal serial of reservation maintained for the members of the public:—

- (i) Chairman, University Grants Commission/Vice Chancellors of Universities.
- (ii) Principal Secretary/PSO to the President of CMLA.
- (iii) Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister.
- (iv) Members, Planning Commission.
- (v) Chairman and Members of Bangladesh Public Service Commission (when the Commission travel as a body not more than two coup Compartments will be provided to the Commission, *i.e.* to the Chairman and Members.)
- (vi) Governor of Bangladesh Bank.
- (vii) Secretaries to the Government of Bangladesh.
- (viii) Advisors of the Prime Minister of Bangladesh.

- (ix) Additional Secretaries or officers holding rank and status of an Additional Secretary.
- (x) Joint Secretaries or Officers holding rank and status of Joint Secretary.
- (xi) IG Of Police.
- (xii) Additional Attorney General.
- (xiii) Deputy Governor, Bangladesh Bank.
- (xiv) The Ambassadors and High Commissioners of Bangladesh (while travelling within Bangladesh).
- (xv) Chairman, Atomic Energy Commission.
- (xvi) Chairman of all autonomous bodies if holding the rank of Secretary.
- (xvii) Director General, National Security and Intelligence.
- (xviii) Chief Controller of Exports and Imports.
- (xix) Director General, Radio Bangladesh.
- (xx) Director General, Posts Offices.
- (xxi) Chairman, T&T.
- (xxii) Director General, Primary Education.
- (xxiii) Director General, Secondary and Higher Secondary Education.
- (xxiv) Director General, Health Services.
- (xxv) Chief Engineer, PWD.
- (xxvi) Chief Engineer, Housing and Settlement.
- (xxvii) Chief Architect, Government of Bangladesh.

Note.—The Director General, Railway-cum-Secretary, Railway Division, Ministry of Communications, Government of Bangladesh holds a Gold Pass and is thereby entitled to the privileges attached to the Gold Pass. If however, the Director General, Railway/Secretary, Railway Division chooses to travel in the train service in H.O.R. he will be entitled to an air-conditioned coup or 1st Class coup compartment as may be available on the relevant train in such a case the charge will be debited at full tariff rate for the accommodation provided on H.O.R. and no credit will be allowed for the Gold Pass held.
