ORDER

Rawalpindi, the 17th July 1968.

- S.R.O. 1171(K)/68.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Central Government is pleased to make the following Order:—
- 1. (1) This Order may be called the Import Policy (July-December, 1968) Order.
 - (2) It shall remain in force until the thirty-first day of December, 1968.
- 2. In this Order, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context:—
 - (a) "actual user" means a person, group of persons, institution, body or organisation to whom an import licence is issued by the licensing authority for the import of an item for the use of, or consumption by, such person, group, institution, body or organisation;
 - (b) "Annex" means an annex to this Order;
 - (c) "approved entitlement" means the half-yearly entitlement recognised by the licensing authority for the purpose of issuing import licences for raw materials and spare parts for machinery to an industrial consumer;
 - (d) "category" means the half-yearly entitlement recognised by the licensing authority and shown in the Pass Books for the purpose of issuing import licences to a commercial importer;
 - (e) "commercial importer" means a firm, institution, body, organisation or person or group of persons registered as an importer under the Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1952, to whom a regular category in a commodity has been assigned on the basis of past performance in import trade;
 - (f) "industrial consumer" means an industrial unit, establishment or undertaking which, being an actual user, is registered as an importer under the Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1952; and
 - (g) "licensing authority" means the Chief Controller of Imports and Exports and includes the Controllers of Imports and Exports and such other officers as may be authorised to issue licences under sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950).

- 3. Items for Import.—Items permissible for import during July-December, 1968, are listed in Annex I and are divided into three parts as given below:—
 - (i) Items on Free List.—These items are listed in List I and can be imported in accordance with provisions of paragraph 29.
 - (ii) Items on Licensable List.—These items are listed in List II. Licences for these items will issue on specific basis.
 - (iii) Items on Cash-cum-Bonus List.—These items are listed in List III.

 Licences for these items shall issue on surrender of bonus vouchers for 50% of the share or entitlement.
- 4. Items on Bonus List.—Items importable under the Export Bonus Scheme shall be such as may be notified by the Ministry of Commerce in this behalf.
- 5. Banned items—Items not included in the Free List, Licensable List, Cash-Cum-Bonus List or in the list of items importable under the Export Bonus Scheme shall be treated as ineligible for import.
- 6. Description of Items.—Description of items in Annex I is generic. Import of only such goods and commodities will be permissible as are covered by these items, except such goods and commodities as have been specifically excluded. A licence issued for generic items will not be valid for any specific item which has been excluded or may be excluded even if such exclusion is not specifically mentioned in the licence.
- Import of Second-hand Commodities.—Unless otherwise specifically permitted, second-hand, reconditioned goods or factory rejects will not be permissible for import.
- 8. Industrial Items.—Items meant exclusively for industrial consumers have been marked with an asterisk (*).
- 9. Items earmarked for specified region.—Where an item is meant for a particular region an indication to that effect has been given against that item.
- 10. Import of explosives, Calcium carbide, Empty gas cylinders and gas in cylinders—Import of explosives, calcium carbide, empty gas cylinders and gas in cylinders shall be effected with the prior approval of Department of Explosives (Industries Division), Government of Pakistan.
- 11. Import through Trading Corporation of Pakistan Limited.—(1) Import of such items as may be notified by the Ministry of Commerce shall be made through the Trading Corporation of Pakistan Limited. The cligible importers shall be required to place orders on the Corporation for these items in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Ministry of Commerce Notification No. S. R. O. 171(R)/67, dated the 12th September, 1967.
- (2) The orders placed on the Trading Corporation of Pakistan Limited will be in accordance with the basis announced by the licensing authority.
- (3) Import of the following items shall be made through the Trading Corporation of Pakistan Limited, namely:—
 - (1) Pig iron.
 - (2) Steel billets from non-US Sources.
 - (3) Steel strips.
 - (4) Aluminium ingots.
 - (5) Copper rods.
 - (6) Zinc.
 - (7) Sulphur.
 - (8) Raw Rubber.
 - (9) Betel-nuts.
 - (10) Artsilk yarn.
- 12. Source of Finance.—Import will be allowed under cash, loan, credit and barter.
- 13. Source of Imports.—(1) Imports under cash licences will be permissible from all countries except where otherwise specified. In case of Loan, Credit, Barter or Trade Agreements, imports will be allowed only from the specified source. No imports shall be permissible from Israel, South Africa, Rhodesia and India
- (2) Import of ferro-chrome made outside Rhodesia of material exported from Rhodesia will not be permissible. All importers of ferro-chrome will have to furnish supplier's certificate to the Customs authorities at the time of clearance that their imports are not affected by the ban. No clearance will be allowed unless the certificate is produced.

- (3) Goods shipped to Pakistan from the following ports in Portuguese Africa will be subject to pre-shipment inspection arrangements:—
 - (1) Lourence Merques.
 - (2) Vila de-Jao Belo.
 - (3) Inhambane.
 - (4) Nova Sofala.
 - (5) Beira.
 - (6) Mozambique.
 - (7) Porto Amelia.
 - (8) Nacala.
 - (9) Quelimane.

The pre-shipment inspection will be carried out at the mill's premises at supplier's cost by an internationally recognised agency. The inspection agency will be selected by the supplier himself with the previous approval of the Ministry of Commerce.

A supplier who wants to tranship goods from any of the above ports will also be required to get the consignments inspected at the port of transhipment in the manner indicated above. The inspection report, in original, testifying that the goods imported are not of Rhodesian origin shall be produced at the time of clearance from the Customs.

- (4) If the import of an item is permissible under barter or loan only and any commercial importer or industrial consumer entitled to import such items from barter or loan countries does not effect any imports under barter or loan he shall be liable to be deprived of future licences under cash.
- Imports under loan, credit or barter—(1) Imports under loan or credit will be subject to the conditions and formalities specified in Annex. II.
- (2) Minimum unit for individual contract has been specified under certain loans or credits. If the individual share of two of more importers falls below the prescribed minimum unit of contract, such importers shall group themselves for arranging import on joint basis.
- (3) Imports under Barters will be tied to the barter country concerned and import licences will not be valid for remittance of foreign exchange. Import of specified items will be made from barter sources as announced from time to time subject to the availability of funds thereunder.
- (4) Letters of credit under Barters, Loan or Credits shall be opened through the banks designated for the purpose by the State Bank of Pakistan within the allocations indicated by the Chief Controller.
- 15. Adjustment—(1) Licences will be issused to industrial consumers and commercial importers after adjustment of any amount licensed in advance.
- (2) Clearance of imports in contravention of ITC or AID Regulations will be refused or if allowed, it will be against surrender of bonus vouchers provided import of the item involved is not totally banned. This will be without prejudice to any action that may be taken under the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950, or the Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1952.
- 16. Validity.—(1) Import licence will be vaild for the period between the date of issue and the date of validity mentioned in the licence which would normally be six months subject to the condition that any shipment made from exporting country before the date of issue of the licence or before opening of letter of credit or after the expiry of the validity period would constitute a contravention of the ITC Regulations.
- (2) Letters of credit under Free List will not be valid for more than six months.
- 17. Revalidation of Licences.—Extension of the validity of licence shall not be allowed except on the grounds of force majeure or in case where revalidation is permitted against the licensee's future share. The decision of the licensing authority in this respect shall be final.
- 18. Presentation of Licence Form—(1) Commercial importers and indus trial consumers wherever eligible will submit licence forms for authentication only through the scheduled banks nominated by them. Licence forms will be authenticated by the licensing authority and will be registered with the State Bank of Pakistan before delivery at the counter. Application for any amendment or revalidation should also be submitted by the licence holders through their nominated banks only.
- (2) Last date for receipt of licence forms shall be the 16th December, 1968.

- 19. Availability of Funds.—Issue of licence and opening of letter of credit will depend on availability of funds.
- 20. Claim for Licence.—No claim for licence shall be entertained against the share admitted under the Review, Appeal and Revision Order, 1957, if the item is no longer licensable. Licences against an admitted appeal, review or revision will be issued in accordance with the licensing procedure in force at the time of issue of licence.
- 21. Procedure of Imports—Imports will be permissible only against irrevocable letters of credit. Import of books, journals and magazines and periodicals will, however, be permissible on a sight Draft and Usance Bills basis also.
- 22. Import at Competitive Rates.—Imports shall be made at the most competitive rates. Importers may be required at any time to submit documents for scrutiny concerning prices paid by them. Those who are found to have indulged in any malpractice may, without prejudice to any action that may be taken under the Imports & Exports (Control) Act, 1950, and the Registration (Importers and Exporters) Order, 1952, be required to surrender bonus vouchers. The decision of the Chief Controller in all such matters shall be final and binding.
- 23. Interwing Movement.—Interwing movement of imported goods except books, journals and magazines will not be permitted without prior clearance from the competent authority. There will, however, be no restriction on the interwing movement of items which are importable exclusively under bonus in both the wings except items which bear different rates of Custom Duty in the two wings, viz., Machinery, etc.
- 24. Concession for obtaining Licence for Lesser Value.—Without prejudice to their future licence, commercial importers and industrial consumers will be permitted to present licence forms or open letter of credit under Free List for an amount less than their entitlement worked out on the basis of licensing factor or otherwise in accordance with this Order, but in such cases source of procurement, if any specified, will not be changed.
- 25. Pre-check of Prices.—All imports of iron and steel mill material covered by Part I of I.T.C. Schedule are subject to pre-check of prices. Letter of credit for these items will be opened only after an importer has obtained pre-check price certificate from the licensing authority concerned.
- 26. Import of Goods (Price Equalisation Surcharge Act, 1967).—Consignments of items which are subject to levy of price equalisation surcharge under the Import of Goods (Price Equalisation Surcharge) Act, 1967 (III of 1967), will be allowed clearance by Customs on deposit of the surcharge determined by the appropriate authorities,
- 27. Indenting.—Before processing of letters of credit, banks shall ensure that an invoice, order or indent has been issued by an indenting agent duly registered as such with the licensing authority.
- 28. Payment of Licence Fee.—A receipted treasury challan (original) showing payment of fee in aecordance with the Licences and Permits Fees Order, 1958, shall be submitted by the persons concerned to the scheduled bank at the time a letter of credit is opened. In cases where imports take place on basis other than letter of credit, the receipted treasury challan (original) showing payment of fee shall be submitted to the banks at the time of retirement of the documents.
- 29. Items on Free List.—(1) Import of items on the Free List shall be permissible without cover of import licence. Import shall not, however, be allowed by air freight unless prior approval is obtained from regional Controllers.
- (2) Industrial Consumers.—All industries shall be allowed to open letters of credit up to 100% of their half yearly entitlement as recorded in their pass books. Wire Nails manufacturing industry shall, however, be eligible to open letter of credit for import of 'Nail Wire' without size restriction for not more than 10% of their half yearly entitlement.
- (3) Commercial Importers.—Commercial Importers will be entitled to open letters of credit for the same items and the same amounts for

which they opened letters of credit for their shares for January-June, 1968, subject to the monetary limits shown below against each item:-

- (4) Any importer who imports any machinery under Tools and Workshop Equipment for setting up of any new units or for balancing and modernisation (including additions) of any existing unit shall not be granted any recognition by the licensing authority unless he has obtained prior valid permission for the purpose.
- 30. Specific source of Procurement under Free List.—Letters of credit for the following commodities covered by Free List can be opened with immediate effect from the sources indicated against each. Additional sources of procurement under loans and barters will be notified later.

- 31. Basis of Licensing under the Licensable List.—(1) Basis of licensing for the items on the licensable list will be announced by the regional Controllers.
- (2) Licences for such items as were on Free List in the past shall issue to only such importers as have imports under Free List to their credit, in accordance with the terms adopted in the July-December, 1967, shipping period.
- (3) Actual users.—Actual users desiring to import any of the following items shall submit their applications to the licensing authority concerned with an undertaking that the goods imported against the licence applied for will be for the actual use of importer only and shall not be sold or transferred to any one else at any stage except with the prior permission of the licensing authority concerned. The applicants shall also be required to give details of licences already received by them in the past for the item applied for:-
 - (i) Technical and Text Books by recognised Technical Institutions and Universities.
 - Chemicals re-agents and reference standards of specific grade in small packing (under Free List from tied sources) by private clinics, laboratories, research institutes and recognised educational institutions.
 - (iii) Homoeopathic and biochemic medicines at Rs.500 each by leading practitioners only.

- (iv) Laboratory glassware graduated and ungraduated (from U.S.A. only) by actual users in medical profession, Pharmaceutical Industry, recognised colleges and technical institutions.
- (v) Electro medical apparatus and appliances including X-ray and ECG equipment and parts and accessories thereof by actual user in medical profession and private hospitals (from U.S.A. only).
- (vi) Scientific instruments, apparatus and appliances (from U.S.A. only) by Pharmaceutical Industry on the recommendation of Director of Industries for quality control purposes, recognised colleges and technical institutions.
- (vii) X-ray films and plates by private clinics having X-ray plants and hospitals.
- (viii) Optical instruments excluding binocular by recognised institutes, private medical practitioners and Pharmaceutical Industry (from U.S.A. only).
- (4) Specific items.—Imports of maps, charts and geographical globes, which do not define the territories of Pakistan, the status of Jammu and Kashmir and the status of the States of Junagarh, Manavadar and Mangrol in accordance with the maps published by the Department of Survey of Pakistan shall not be permissible.
- (5) Drugs and medicines.—(a) Commercial Importers.—Import of drugs and medicines (allopathic) will be subject to the list of items given in Annex. III, which will apply to licences issued on or after date of issue of this Order. Licences shall issue according to the basis announced by the regional Controllers.
- (b) Annex. XXIV gives a list of items of Drugs and Medicines importable under Bonus exclusively.
 - (6) Tractors.—Import of tractors, power tillers and agricultural implements and spare parts thereof by commercial importers shall not be permissible for any purpose other than agriculture.

Licences shall issue only to such importers as fulfil the following conditions, namely:—

- (a) they have established a mobile workshop, and
- (b) they have adequate arrangements for the supply of spare parts and maintenance,
- 32. Cash-cum-Bonus List.—Issue of cash portion for an item on the Cash-cum-Bonus list shall be subject to importers' obtaining licence under bonus for 50% of the share in the first instance. Bonus portion of the licence shall also be valid for import of the same item only.
 - 33. Basis of Licensing under Cash-cum-Bonus List:-
 - Commercial importers.—Licences shall issue at rates to be notified by the Controllers.
 - (2) Actual users.—Licences to actual users for any of the following items shall issue automatically for reasonable amounts on surrender of bonus vouchers for 50% of the share by the licensing authority concerned, on production of an undertaking to the effect that the goods imported against the licence applied for will be for actual use of the importer only and shall not be sold or transferred to anyone else at any stage except with the prior permission of the licensing authority:—
 - (i) Laboratory glassware graduated and ungraduated by actual users in the medical profession, pharmaceutical industry, recognised colleges and technical institutions.
 - (ii) Electro medical apparatus and appliances including X-ray and ECG equipment and parts and accessories thereof by actual users in medical profession and private hospitals.
 - (iii) Scientific instruments, apparatus and appliances by Pharmaceutical industry on the recommendation of Director of Industries for quality control purposes, recognised colleges and technical institutions.
 - (iv) Surgical instruments, apparatus and appliances by actual users in medical profession.
 - (v) Optical instruments excluding binocular by recognised institutes, private medical practitioners and pharmaceutical industry.
 - (vi) Three-wheeler auto-rickshaws without bodies (for East Pakistan only).

- (3) Industrial consumers.—Recognised industrial units shall get licences at 100% of their half yearly entitlement as recorded in their Pass Books issued by the Licensing authority except the mirror industry which will be licensed for sheet and plate glass above 5 mm at 25% of their entitlement for this item and commercial vehicles assembly which will be licensed at specific basis.
- (4) Maintenance spares and components.—Maintenance spares and accessories for machinery for all industries and components for assembly or manufacture of items given in Annex. IV shall be licensed at 100% of half yearly entitlement under cash-cum-bonus scheme.
- 34. Enhancement of Industrial Entitlement.—Enhancement of entitlement will be given effect to only in the period subsequent to the period in which a Licensing Board accepts the same.

35. Export Performance Licensing Scheme:-

- (1) All exporting industries detailed in Annex. V (excluding Jute industry and Cotton textiles) can obtain licences for the import of specific itemes of their production requirements including packing material to the extent specified in that Annex. They will also be allowed to import maintenance spares against their entitlement under export performance.
 - (2) Licences against export performance shall be claimed by the unit concerned within six months of the realisation of their sale-proceeds, failing which the share of unit shall stand forfeited.
 - (3) All applications for issue of licences against exports shall be accompanied by the following documents—
 - (a) Invoice containing GRPI Form No. and date.
 - (b) Bill of Lading indicating GRPI Form No. and date.
 - (c) Foreign exchange realisation certificate authenticated by the State Bank of Pakistan as prescribed in Annex. VI.
- 36. Advance Licensing for Exports.—Issue of import licences in advance for export performance shall be subject to production of an undertaking and bank guarantee as prescribed in Annex. VII subject to clearance of earlier guarantees. Requests for advance licences from Export Industries entitled to performance licences above 10% will be considered on merits.
- 37. Leather goods including leather footwear and readymade garments industries, previously on the Export Linking Scheme will now get their share under normal and export performance licensing like other industries.
- 38. Import under Bonus.—Import of all items on the Free List, Licensable List or Cashs-cum-Bonus List shall be permissible under Bonus also except sheet and plate glass.
- 39. Licensing counters.—Licence forms relating to all classes of imports will be presented at the licensing counters detailed below according to the location of the importers—
 - (1) The Controller of Imports and Exports, Karachi.
 - (2) The Controller of Imports and Exports, Lahore.
 - (3) The Assistant Controller of Imports and Exports, Hyderabad.
 - (4) The Assistant Controller of Imports and Exports, Peshawar.
 - (5) The Assistant Controller of Imports and Exports, Quetta.
 - (6) The Assistant Controller of Imports and Exports, Rawalpindi.
 - (7) The Controller of Imports and Exports, Dacca.
 - (8) The Joint Controller of Imports and Exports, Chittagong.
 - (9) The Assistant Controller of Imports and Exports, Khulna.
 - (10) The Assistant Controller of Imports and Exports, Rajshahi.

ANNEXURE II

PROCEDURE FOR IMPORTS UNDER DIFFERENT LOANS/CREDITS.

(A) U.S. AID/LOAN:

- 1. Source-Imports shall be restricted to USA only.
- 2. Minimum Unit—Minimum unit has been fixed at \$5,000 (Supplies invoices for partial shipments less than \$1,000 except ocean freight or insurance invoice shall not be eligible for AID financing). The effective value for imports is the dollar value. No letter of credit shall be opened for an amount less than \$,000.

- 3. OSB Notices and bid date—50 days notice in triplicate (45 days for publication and 5 days for transmission) for commodities costing \$5,000 and above containing their specifications in terms of US standards and other procurement data, in the English Language shall be sent to the Office of the Small Business Material Resources, AID Washington DC 20523, USA through the designated bank. Importers will not finalise contracts until expiry of bid date fixed date on basis of publication of O.S.B. notices by AID Washington or on issuance of waiver of OSB requirements by AID. Amendment to OSB notices will not be processed instead fresh OSB notices shall be submitted to the designated banks for which new bid dates will be assigned. A copy of OSB Notice shall be submitted to the regional offices of AID, Alflah Building, Lahore/Adamjee Courts, Dacca by importers located in West/East Pakistan respectively. As Letters of Credit have to be opened for all the items published in OSB circulars and for amounts indicated against each of them, it is essential that importers should check up the items and their share/entitlement carefully before sending OSB notices. The designated banks shall also ensure that the amount of letters of credit do not exceed the share/entitlement of importers fixed on the basis announced by Chief Controller/Controller of Imports and Exports.
- 4. Price.—Purchases shall be made at the most competitive prices whicht should not exceed the suppliers customary export price.
- Banks.—Business will be transacted on Letter of Credit basis only through Paklstani and American Banks designated to handle the businees.
 - 6. Shipments.—Shipping conditions will be notified for each AID Loan.
- 7. Ineligible suppliers.—List of suppliers declared ineligible to take part in AID financed transactions are notified from time to time. Importers shall ensure that no transaction is finalised with any of parties declared ineligible Public Notice No. 65 (68)/Import-R, dated 26-6-68 refers).

(B) N. I. BANK LOAN (Dutch Loan):

- (i) The Imports will take place from world wide sources but before orders for procurement from countries other than Netherlands are placed the Dutch exporters are not to be treated less favourably than other exporters. Should a particular agreed item be not available at all in Netherlands or not available at competitive prices and other terms of part of this loan can be utilised outside the Netherlands. In case of procurement from sources otherwise the Netherlands, specific agreement of the N. I. Bank will have to be obtained. In such cases the designated Bank will make a reference to the Economic Affairs Division so that specific agreement with N. I. Bank may be obtained by them.
- (ii) The shipments under this Loan will be on C and F basis. It is not compulsory to use Dutch Flag Vessels.
- (iii) The Pakistani Importers will finalise contracts with the Dutch suppliers and approach the designated Bank directly or through their own bankers for establishment of Letters of Credit which shall be expressed in Dutch Guilders only. The designated Bank will scrutinize the contracts as to the eligibility or otherwise of the items under this loan.

(C) U. K. LOAN:

- 1. Source.—Import shall be confined to goods U. K. origin and from U. K only.
- Import shall take place on Letter of Credit basis only through the designated bank.
- 3. The exporter in U. K. after finalising their contracts with the Pakistani Importers, shall send direct to Pakistan High Commission, London, the following:—
 - (a) four copies of each contract so negotiated, and
 - (b) six copies of a contract certificate in the prescribed form completed by the Supplier in U. K.

for obtaining approval of the U. K. Government, which is communicated by the U. K. authorities to Economic Affairs Division, Islamabad. Letters of Credit shall be opened by Pakistani Importers only on receipt of such approval from Economic Affairs Division.

(D) WEST GERMAN LOAN:

1. Source.—Import will be confined to goods of West German origin and from West Germany only.

- 2. Imports shall take place on Letter of Credit basis only through designated banks. Effective value for imports is the Deutsche Marks.
- 3. The importers shall cover the fluctuation on the rates of Deutsche Marks by taking a forward cover from their bankers.
- 4. Shipment shall take place either on West Germany or on Pak. Flag Vessels.

(E) CANADIAN ASSISTANCE:

- 1. Source.—Procurement shall be confined to commodities of Canadian origin and from Canada only.
- 2. Buyers shall have to invite tenders from an approved list of Canadian suppliers and send copies of tenders together with the names of tenders invited to tenders to external AID Office simultaneously. Buyers shall instruct Canadian suppliers invited to tenders to send a copy of their tender to External AID Office together with a completed Canadian Content Declaration from at the same time as the tender is submitted to the buyer.
- 3. The lowest tender meeting the required information specification should be accepted.
- 4. A copy of purchase order/contract shall be sent to Canadian suppliers and External AID simultaneously through the licensing offices concerned who will forward it with a certificate that the purchase is being so financed out of Canadian assistance.
- 5. All imports shall take place against Letters of Credit which shall be opened after approval of the purchase order by the Canadian authorities through designated bank covering f. a. s. cost of commodities. Buyers shall instruct suppliers to send their invoices covering the f. a. s. cost of the commodities to the Canadian authorities for payment. Cost of ocean freight, insurance, loading and handling charges will be met by the State Bank of Pakistan by establishing a letter of credit in favour of the Canadian suppliers.
- 6. In case there is any commodity item which is put on free list and to be imported trom Canada under Canadian Assistance, and import authorisation will be obtained from the CCI & E and submitted to the Canadian authorities through their suppliers along with the invoices covering f. a. s. cost of the commodities

(F) ITALIAN CREDIT:

- 1. Source.-Imports shall be confined to Italian origin and from Italy only.
- 2. As soon as the importer signs the contract, he should approach the Italian supplier with the request to contact the Ministry of Foreign Trade, Rome for their authorization of the contract under the Italian Consortium credit to Pakistan,

Simultaneously the importing agency should forward 10 copies of the contract under this credit to the designated banks concerned. The designated banks after scru'inising the contracts with regard to the credit terms will forward 8 copies of the contract to the Economic Affairs Division, Islamabad for approval along with a certificate about their scrutiny of the said terms. On receipt of the designated bank's recommendations, the Government of Pakistan's approval will be conveyed to Italian Ministry of Foreign Trade through the Embassy of Pakistan in Italy. On receipt of the approval of the Italian Government, the Economic Affairs Division will advise the designated banks to proceed with the implementation of the contract.

(G) JAPAN CREDIT (YEN CREDIT):

- Source.—Procurement shall be confined to goods of Japan origin and from Japan only.
- 2. The minimum value of the individual contracts for Dyes and Chemicals shall not be below Yen 9,000,000 (\$25,000) and that for Marine Diesel Engines and Power Tillers Yen 36,000,000 (\$100,000). In case individual shares of importers fall below the minimum unit, the importers shall group themselves for import on joint basis. The effective value of these licences shall be in Japanese Yens and the rupee value would be indicated for the purpose of convenience only.

3. After finalising contracts with Japanese suppliers, the importers shall furnish contracts together with application for approval in the prescribed form to Economic Affairs Division, Islamabad through the designated bank concerned. Letter of credit shall be opened only after Economic Affairs Division have communicated the approval of Eximbank Japan.

(H) FRENCH CREDITS:

- 1. Source—Procurement shall be made from France through suppliers registered in France and shall also be confined to eligible commodities of French origin.
- 2. Minimum Unit.—The Minimum Unit for each contract pertaining to fertilizers is \$60,000 and for contracts pertaining to Dyes and Chemicals and Pharmceuticals is \$40,000.
- 3. A provisional contract shall be negotiated with French suppliers for import of commodities. In case of doubt regarding eligibility of items and/or of the French firm either the French suppliers be asked to obtain a Provisional guarantee from French authorities or the position be ascertained informally from the French Trade Commissioner. In case the iudividual shares/entitlements of importer fall below the minimum unit of contract, importers shall group themselves for import on joint basis 20 copies of the contract shall be sent to Habib Bank Limited, Karachi. The Habib Bank Limited will take full responsibility for scrutinizing the contracts with regard to the credit terms of the French credit and issuing guarantee before notifying them to the French Commercial Counseller in Pakistan. Along with the letter of notification a copy of the contract will be attached. A copy of the notification issued to the French Commercial Counciller in Pakistan together with four copies of the contract shall be forwarded to Economic Affairs Division.
- 4. The contract shall be concluded with the French suppliers on the contract form (specimen attached) in accordance with its provisions and will be forwarded to the Habib Bank Ltd., Karachi for opening of Letters of Credit.

PAYMENT:

In conformity with the stipulations of the agreement passed between Habib Bank and B. F. C. E. relating to the utilisation of the Washington Club French Credit for Commodities period 196/196 and under the guarantee of the State Bank of Pakistan. The contents of such agreement is well known by buyer and seller and fully agreed by them.

The payment under this contract will be as follows:

- (a) 5% of the contract value by transfer effected by Habib Bank to B. F. C. E. as soon as the Economic Affairs Division and the French Trade Commissioner have mutually notified their agreement.
- (b) 5% proportionately to each delivery and 5% at the time of the last delivery by utilisation of an irrevocable documentary credit opened by Habib Bank at B. F. C. E. at the time of the above-mentioned transfer.
